Exceptions can be granted by the SSVC and the decision of the Committee will be final. The usual term of the scholarship will be the full Academic Year (fall and spring), with the possibility of a summer renewal depending on fund availability. At the end of each semester, the recipient's record will be reviewed. To be considered for continuance (for academic year scholarships) or for renewal (for summer or subsequent academic years), the recipient will be expected to: 1. Participate in the URI Veteran Student Association, 2. Participate on the URI Supports Student Veterans Committee, 3. Maintain a minimum GPA of 2.00, 4. Maintain seven or more credits (unless approved for fewer credits), 5. Follow all student conduct rules 6. Represent the University of Rhode Island in a positive manner. Students who fail to meet these terms may be required to reimburse scholarship funding as determined by the University.
