

2012 Rhode Island 4-H Horse Activity Score Sheet – Teen Leader

This application is for those who would like to be considered for the New England 4-H Horse Activity as a Teen Leader at the Eastern States Exposition in West Springfield, Massachusetts in September. The State 4-H Office will make final selections. If more than four (4) 4-H members meet all the requirements, then the applicants with the most points will be given first consideration.

Other requirements of being an ESE Teen Leader: (1) age 12 or over by January 1st of the current year, (2) completed one year or more of 4-H horse project work, (3) ride, drive, in hand and/or volunteer during the current calendar year in at least one of the District 4-H Horse Shows or State 4-H Horse clinic (serves as qualifier for riders only) as well as the State 4-H Horse Show, (4) members must be recommended by their 4-H leader, (5) Teen Leader Essay must be attached to this Score Sheet, and (6) members must score a minimum 70 points on this activity sheet to be eligible to be an ESE Teen Leader.

This completed score sheet with attached essay, along with your ESE 4-H Horse Entry Application, is due no later than **AUGUST 1ST**, in the State 4-H Office, Peckham Farm, URI, Kingston, RI 02881. **There will be no exceptions.**
