Learn to paint a dynamic, crashing wave using acrylic paints, paint brushes and even your fingers! Similar in style to the Great Wave by Hokusai

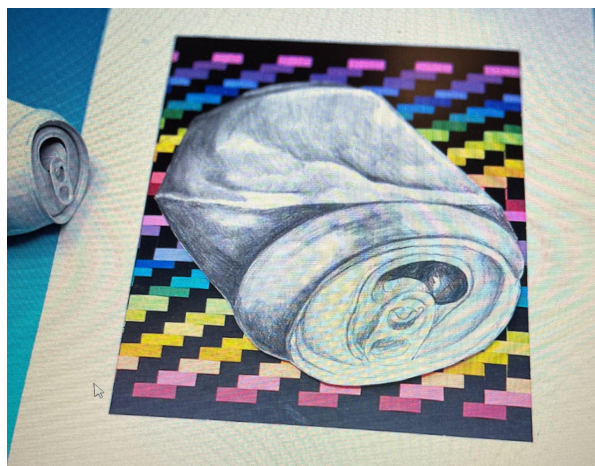
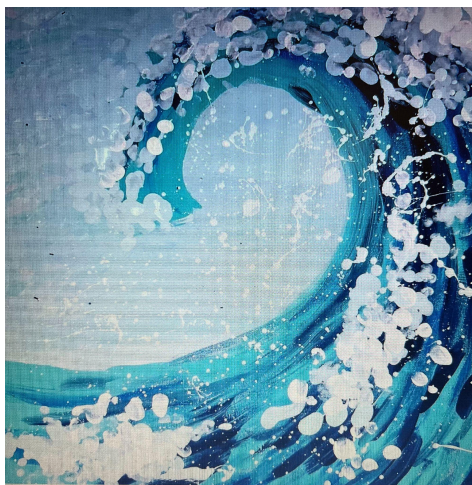
7:00-8:30 PM Soda Can Drawing- Age 11-18
