



COOPERATIVE EXTENSION RI 4-H ANIMAL MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT

Goals: Management agreements are a way to allow more youth to experience working with live animal projects. During the management 4-Hers learn to train, care for the project animal.

Rights & Responsibilities:

4-Her will treat the animal(s) humanely, bear all expenses incurred in transporting and/or exhibiting the animal, 4-Her may keep any premiums or awards during the management period. If this agreement is terminated early the animal may be managed by another 4-H youth for the remainder of the season however it cannot go the Big E. Owners will be responsible for any breeding of the animal; prodigy born and retain ownership of the prodigy and hold title/registration. Owners assume all legal responsibility as owner of the animal and agree not to hold the 4-H'er liable for any injury or death of the animal, except those due to negligence on the part of the 4-H'er. Owners will bear all expenses normally incurred in raising such an animal unless otherwise noted. Owners will not exhibit or show the animals during the management time. Please list any other specific expectations of the 4-H youth or the owner on the back of this form.
