- Completed Common Application.
- \$65 application fee.
- Official high school transcript (recommended).
- Completed "Self-Reported Academic Record" (SRAR) in the student applicant portal.
- List of senior courses.
- At least one letter of recommendation (pharmacy applicants are required to submit two letters).
- Transcript of college credits earned in high school if applicable.
- Enrolling students must also submit an official final high school transcript by July 1 showing proof of high school graduation.
