- Official high school transcript or official copies of GED scores, unless you have an associate or bachelor's degree with coursework similar in content to what is offered at URI.

RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS

Tuition classification determines if students should have instate or out-of-state tuition. Your initial tuition classification is determined from information you supply on your application for admission to the University. VETERANS' EDUCATIONAL BENEFITS AND FINANCIAL AID

The University accepts all VA Benefits including Chapter 30, Chapter 31, Chapter 33, Chapter 35, as well as the State Tuition Waiver (STAP) for our RI National Guard, and the Disabled American Veterans Tuition Waiver (DAV).

All students applying for VA Benefits for the first time should visit https://www.va.gov/. Click "Education Benefits" towards the bottom left, and then "Apply for Education Benefits."

Once applications are approved, the VA issues a Certificate of Eligibility (CoE) to qualified individuals. The certificate will contain basic eligibility information including months of entitlement, period of eligibility, and benefit level. MILITARY CREDIT

Credit for military schooling, both for courses and for occupations, is evaluated upon receipt of Form DD 214, the Service Separation Certificate, a Joint Services Transcript (JST), or a transcript from the Community College of the Air Force (CCAF). Students can also be awarded credit for other military courses and occupations listed on a JST or a transcript from the CCAF, if ACE recommends that the work should be granted upper-division baccalaureate credit. This work, however, transfers to URI as lower-division elective credit.
