A course may meet more than one outcome but cannot be counted towards the 40-credit total. No more than 12 credits can have the same course code (exception: Honor's Program (HPR) courses may have more than 12 credits). Gen Ed courses may also be used to meet requirements of the major or minor. **Entrance into the major requires: A2, B1 and HDF200 or 201 with a C or above.**






First Year Fall




First Year Spring




Sophomore Fall




