







<p><b>Certificates</b></p> <p><b>Early Intervention Certificate:</b> Completion of HDF 306, HD F340, HDF 341, HDF 342, and HDF 343 will earn students the credential of Early Interventionist II endorsed by RI’s Executive Office of Health and Human Services. Courses include HDF/NUR150, HDF 200, 201, 202, 205G, 230, 333 (433), 430, 432, 434, 437, 450, 480/481. 


