The Secondary Education program outlined in the table below offers a BA from the College of Education with a double major in the College of Arts and Sciences (A&S) or the College of Environmental and Life Sciences (CELS). The A&S and CELS major requires a minimum of 30 credit hours. Majors are available in following areas of teacher certification: **Biology, Chemistry, English, History/Social Studies, Mathematics, and Physics**. Certification is also available in **General Science**. Students who must miss a semester, e.g. to study abroad, should meet with their College of Education advisor as early as possible to determine how to complete the required course sequence, e.g. by taking summer courses.
