A course may meet more than one outcome but cannot be counted more than once towards the 40-credit total. No more than 12 credits can have the same course code (exception: Honors Program (HPR)). Gen Ed courses may also be used to meet requirements of the major. **Admission Requirements:** Students seeking admission to the HDF major must have completed 24 credits and completed the following courses with an overall grade point average of 2.00 or better: HDF 200 or 201 and courses meeting each of the following general education requirements: A2. Social and Behavioral Sciences and B1. Write effectively.
