Written Feedback

Great for quick questions and students can visit as much as they like.

Located in library LL4 and open Monday - Thursday from 1pm-7pm.

Great for in-depth knowledge and questions. Same tutor at the same time each week, allowing students to get to know their peers.

Located primarily in Roosevelt and can be online or in person. Use TracCloud to schedule.

Peer consultants help with planning, time management, and study strategies.

Undergraduate students can schedule 50 minute Academic Skills Consultations either in person or online through TracCloud

Dr. David Hayes helps students with all areas of academic skills development including planning, time management, studying, motivation, procrastination, attention, test taking, & test anxiety.

Undergraduate students can schedule 30 min, 1-1 consultations (in person or online) via starfish.

UCS 160: Success in Higher Education and **UCS 161: Becoming a More Self Directed Learner** are 1 credit courses that teach college-specific planning, work management and study skills.

UCS 160 is open to all undergraduates. 161 has 160 as a prerequisite, or permission of instructor.

Support for any writing assignment, at any stage, and personal statements for applications. Meet 1-on-1 with a writing consultant in Roosevelt 009 or online.

Schedule 25- or 50- minute appointments on WOnline via SSO in My Apps.

Submit a substantial draft along with questions or concerns for targeted feedback. Best for later-stage drafts, and consultation follow-ups.

Next-day feedback available Monday through Friday.
