Meet 1-on-1 with a peer writing consultant in Roosevelt 009 or online. You can bring any writing assignment, at any stage (even if you haven't started writing yet). We can also help with personal statements for applications.

Schedule 25- or 50-minute appointments on WOnline via SSO in My Apps.

If you've already met with a consultant 1-1 and you have a well-developed draft, you can submit your work for written feedback. A peer consultant will respond to your questions or concerns in writing.
