



RI Society of CPAs 2025 Scholarship Application Process

Rhode Island Society of CPAs is pleased to announce the scholarship application process for 2024-2025 is now open. Rhode Island students pursuing an accounting or finance major at any private or public college or university who meet the criteria are encouraged to apply. All applicants must provide proof they are Rhode Island citizen.

<u>Carl W. Christiansen Scholarship</u> - *Applicant may attend any accredited college or university.*The late Carl W. Christiansen, CPA established a scholarship fund in 1974. The purpose of this fund was to assist students who hope to join the public accounting profession, by granting scholarships to help defray the cost of a college education.

<u>Cheryl A. Ruggiero Scholarship</u> - *Open to female applicants who may attend any accredited college or university.* A scholarship fund was established in 2005 for the late Cheryl A. Ruggiero, CPA. The purpose of this fund is to assist <u>female</u> accounting students who hope to join the public accounting profession, by granting scholarships to help defray the cost of a college education.

KLR/Brian A. Altomari Memorial Fund Scholarship - Applicant must be attending a RI university or college. A scholarship grant was established in 2018 for the KLR/Brian A. Altomari Memorial Fund. The scholarship, which is dispensed through the RI Foundation, is intended for a student attending or planning to enroll in an accredited college or university in Rhode Island who will be a major in accounting.

Criteria for Applicants

- Applicants must be a legal resident of the State of Rhode Island and a citizen of the United States.
- Applicant must demonstrate an interest in accounting during the undergraduate/graduate years.
- Applicant must obtain an overall academic average of 3.0, and in the opinion of the Accounting Department faculty, demonstrate the potential to become a valued member of the Public Accounting Profession.

Guidelines

- Complete the application in full. Use the reverse side if additional space is necessary.
- Submit a short personal statement that reflects your interest in the accounting profession.
- Submit a copy of your transcript.
- Submit one letter of recommendation from a member of the accounting/finance department of your school.
- Submit proof of BOTH: U.S. Citizenship and Rhode Island residency.
 - o Examples: Birth certificate, copy of driver's license, state-issued identification card.
