## **College of Business Administration Innovation and Entrepreneurship Minor**

This 18-credit formalized minor is designed to give students the opportunity to gain innovative thinking and entrepreneurial skills to supplement their major. This minor is open to both business and nonbusiness majors, except for INE majors.

## **REQUIREMENTS FOR THE INNOVATION AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP MINOR ARE:**

- 1. Students must declare Innovation and Entrepreneurship as a minor field of study the semester in which the student expects to complete 75 credit hours. Requirements are satisfied by completion of the 18 credits of related studies offered by the College of Business and the College of Engineering.
- 2. A minimum average of 2.0 must be earned in the 18 credits required for the minor.
- 3. At least 3 courses for the minor must be earned at the University of Rhode Island.
- 4. At least 12 of the 18 credits (4 courses) must be at the 200-level or above.
- 5. No more than two courses may apply to both the major and minor fields of study. Courses in general education may be used for the minor. Courses in the minor may not be taken under the Pass/Fail option.
