

Textiles, Fashion Merchandising and Design Minor Field of Study

1. Application for a **Textiles, Fashion Merchandising and Design minor** for to majors outside of Textiles, Fashion Merchandising and Design and Fashion Business must be filed in the academic dean's office no later than the beginning of the second semester of the student's senior year. Departments and programs may require an application for a minor in advance of the second semester of the senior year, but not before the semester in which 75 credits are completed. 18 credits of related coursework in the College of Business.
2. At least 12 of the 18 credits required for a minor shall be at the 200-level or above. A min. avg. of 2.00 GPA must be earned in for the minor.
3. At least three courses applied to the minor must be completed at the University of Rhode Island.
4. A maximum of two courses required in a major program may be used to apply to both the major and minor fields of study. Courses from other curricula that are recommended or required for the major may apply to the minor. Courses in General Education may be used for the minor. Courses in the minor may not be taken under the pass-fail grading option.
5. Approval of a minor does not guarantee space in any course required for the minor. Taking courses over the summer is strongly advised.
6. If you have not completed all 18 required credits, list all courses already taken/planned to take, including the semester.
