Applying to the URI MBA @ Pfizer Program

Students must apply to the program by June 30, 2026 to be considered for Fall 2026 admittance. Applicants with a bachelor's degree from any accredited college or university, with a minimum 3.00 GPA may apply for admission to *The URI MBA @ PFIZER*. If you have below a 3.00 GPA you may still apply but may be asked to take the GMAT or GRE as part of your admission requirements.

The application will be completed online at <https://gradadmissions.uri.edu/apply/> and includes:

- Brief statement of purpose uploaded (please state in essay that you are applying to The URI MBA @ PFIZER)
- Biographical information
- Application fee (\$65 -paid online)
- One letter of recommendation from your supervisor completed online – you will list their name/email and they will get an email asking to upload the letter to a link given. URI asks for a second letter so please put NA for the second name and use your own email address (not the same one used to apply)
- Current resume - upload to system
- Official college transcripts – upload a copy to the system. An official transcript must also be sent directly from your all undergrad/grad University prior to the start of the program (not due now) to
- If you are a RI resident, you will need to submit a [Certificate of Residency](#) via email to the Graduate School.
- For international candidates: If you did not complete a degree from the US or are not a permanent US citizen, you'll need to submit a language proficiency exam : TOEFL, IELTS or Duolingo. See details [HERE](#) to see if you qualify to waive the exam requirements.

Transfer Courses

URI allows transfer credits from AACSB accredited MBA programs. If you believe you can transfer a course, please contact Lisa Lancellotta at LLancellotta@uri.edu before the start of the program to review your transcript.

Tuition

The tuition is \$2,000 per class. You will be required to pay up front in full before each semester (\$4000 fall/spring and \$2000/summer), as well as purchase the books/materials. The book list will be given to you well in advance of the start of the class. If you are eligible for Pfizer educational reimbursement with this program, be sure to follow Pfizer requirements from Bright Horizons before the start of each course.

Students will have full access to URI services and facilities at the Kingston, RI campus. While it is not necessary to visit the campus, the close proximity to Kingston is an added benefit for those wishing to use the facilities and services. Facilities include the campus library (which is also online), computing center, student ID, counselors and career, cultural and sporting events.

If you are unable to take a course during the rotation, you can take the evening class with our traditional FlexMBA students, subject to URI tuition and fees. If another cohort at Pfizer is started in the future, you can enroll in the missed class with the new cohort.
