## **ITR Internship Program Information**

Summer 2024

- Earn 300-level free elective credit for quality internship experiences in nearly any field anywhere in the US
- Pursue paid and unpaid internships from our established partners or search for new opportunities
- Regular tuition and financial aid remain the same for ITR internship credits

### **Student Requirements**

- Minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA; Good academic and social standing
- Undergraduate student with a minimum of 60 earned credits prior to the internship

#### **Important Dates**

- Session 3: May 20 July 26 | Registration Deadline: May 17
- Alternative Session\*: June 3 August 9 | Registration Deadline: May 31
  - \*Alternative session students might not be eligible for August 2024 graduation. Confirm with your Assistant Dean.

#### **Tuition & Financial Aid**

- Cost of tuition (for BOTH in-state & out-of-state students) = \$261 per credit

### **Hours & Credits**

- ITR credit is just like class credit; students may not take more than 16 total credits during the summer
- ITR 302: The credit for your internship hours. Student & supervisor will complete performance evaluations.
- ITR 304: Required asynchronous online seminar focused on career development and internship support. Includes weekly lessons, discussion, and assignments, such as resume, LinkedIn, mock interview, and more.
