- 1). The CELS Faculty and Professional Staff meeting was called to order at 10:05 a.m. on Wednesday, August 28, 2024 in the Weaver Auditorium with Dean Kirby presiding. There were 84 members of the CELS Faculty and Staff Present, constituting a quorum.

5). Reports of the Standing Committees

- a). Diversity Committee- Dr. Amelia Moore The CELS Diversity Committee Dr. Moore delivered the Diversity Committee Report and announced that Dr. Sunshine Menezes will be the incoming Diversity Committee Chairperson. The Diversity Committee Report is presented in **Appendix 1**.
- b). Curriculum Committee- Dr. Soni Pradhanang The Curriculum Committee presented an overview of course proposals and Program Proposals that were processed in the last year. The Curriculum Committee Report is presented in **Appendix 2**.
- c). Research Committee- Dr. Niall Howlett The Research Committee had nothing to report.
- d). Cooperative Extension and Outreach Coordination Committee (CEOCC)- Extension Specialist Kate Venturini Hardesty. The CEOCC report was deferred to the report by Associate Dean Lisa Townson.
- e). Space Committee- Dr. Corey Lang Space Committee Chairperson Lang reported that there were no new space requests in the Spring of 2024.
- f). Commencement Committee-Dr. John Taylor . Dr. Taylor was not present but it was reported by the Committee that there will be a fall commencement to be held December 14th at 10 a.m. in the Ryan Center. In May 2024 CELS had 325 graduates, and this December, 103 are expected.
- g). Bylaws Committee- Dr. Katherine Petersson. The CELS Bylaws Committee served to compile the CELS committee assignments and acted in the function of the CELS Faculty Secretary during the 2023 to 2024 Academic Year. The Bylaws Committee Report is Presented as **Appendix 3**.

6). Reports of the Dean's Staff

- a). Associate Dean Sartini. Associate Dean Sartini presented the report of the Academic and Student Affairs Committee that included a summary of the demographics of the incoming Fall 2024 CELS freshman class. She announced key dates for faculty awareness and an ATL-sponsored workshop on the use of AI in pedagogy. The Academic and Student Affairs Committee Report is presented as **Appendix 4**.
- b). Associate Dean Wilga. Associate Dean Wilga reported an 8% increase in total research funding awards to CELS in the previous year. She added that the effective return on indirect costs is 25%, which is inadequate in the future with the new budget model. Considerable work on data analysis, publication, etc. are often done on-campus despite field work being done abroad.
- c). Associate Dean Townson. Associate Dean Townson presented the report of the Cooperative Extension and Outreach Report. A major activity of a Cooperative Extension Needs Assessment was undertaken. Thee was an Internal retreat conducted on March 15, 2024, followed by focus groups with external cooperators and clientele in the Summer/Fall 2024. The aim is to update and augment the 2023-2028 Cooperative Extension Implementation Plan. The CEOCC report is presented as **Appendix 5**.
- d). Monica York, Chief Business Officer & Christine Dias, Director, Finance/Administration. Business Officer York introduced Christine Dias, the new Director of Finance and Administration for CELS. Ms. York mentioned there would be a new email address for each of three Administrative Units. ALL initial emails should go through this group questions, purchases, hires, P-cards, etc (Appendix 6). The aim is to cut down on issues if someone is out of the office or over extended. One of the fiscal staff should respond within a 24 hour period after your request is assigned to let you know exactly who will be handling the request from beginning until its resolution. The Business Office will follow up individually.

8). New Business:

- a) Dean Kirby announced that he will retire sometime in 2025 and that efforts are beginning to search for a new dean
- b) Faculty Secretary Rice invited newly hired faculty to engage in the community of CELS governance by service on college committees. He noted that attention to personal P&T is of primary importance, but there are several 'light lift' committees appropriate for junior faculty membership that can help build and maintain the CELS Community.
