Directions: Fill in the blanks with the name of a fruit or vegetable to complete the sentence.



- A** A is for asparagus, green with a pointy tip like a paintbrush.
- B** B is for beets, bright red roots with a long, green stem.
- C** C is for cauliflower, a white vegetable that looks like a fluffy cloud.
- D** D is for dried plum, another name for a prune.
- E** E is for eggplant, dark purple and shiny with a green top.
- F** F is for fig, a chewy and sweet dried fruit, grown on a Ficus tree.
- G** G is for grapefruit, bigger than an orange and makes you pucker.
- H** H is for honeydew melon, similar to a cantaloupe but green on the inside.
- I** I is for iceberg lettuce, a leafy green.
- J** J is for jalapeño, a spicy green pepper.
- K** K is for kiwi, bright green with tiny black seeds and a fuzzy skin.
- L** L is for lemon, bright yellow and used for juice.
- M** M is for mango, an oval shaped fruit that can be yellow, orange, and red.
- N** N is for nectarine, similar to a peach without the fuzz.
- O** O is for orange, a delicious fruit that is great for juice at breakfast.
- P** P is for pumpkin, big and orange and great for carving.
- Q** Q is for quince, similar to a pear and is bright golden yellow.
- R** R is for radish, red and white with a bite!
- S** S is for spinach, a dark leafy green.
- T** T is for tomato, juicy and usually red. It can be a vegetable or a fruit.
- U** U is for ugli, a citrus fruit that is a cross between an orange, grapefruit, and tangerine.
- V** V is for Victorian plum, an English plum that is yellow and red.
- W** W is for watermelon, a summer snack that is juicy and red with black seeds.
- X** X is for Xigua, the Chinese name for watermelon!
- Y** Y is for yam, sometimes called a sweet potato.
- Z** Z is for zucchini, a member of the squash family.
