- A is for asparagus, green with a pointy tip like a paintbrush.
- **B** B if for <u>beets</u>, bright red roots with a long, green stem.
- C is for <u>cauliflower</u>, a white vegetable that looks like a fluffy cloud.
- **D** is for **dried plum**, another name for a prune.
- E is for <u>eggplant</u>, dark purple and shiny with a green top.
- **F** F is for **fig.** a chewy and sweet dried fruit, grown on a Ficus tree.
- **G** G is for **grapefruit**, bigger than an orange and makes you pucker.
- H is for honeydew melon, similar to a cantaloupe but green on the inside.
- I is for <u>iceberg lettuce</u>, a leafy green.
- J is for jalapeño, a spicy green pepper.
- **K** K is for **kiwi**, bright green with tiny black seeds and a fuzzy skin.
- L is for <u>lemon</u>, bright yellow and used for juice.
- M is for <u>mango</u>, an oval shaped fruit that can be yellow, orange, and red.
- N is for <u>nectarine</u>, similar to a peach without the fuzz.
- O is for <u>orange</u>, a delicious fruit that is great for juice at breakfast.
- P P is for <u>pumpkin</u>, big and orange and great for carving.
- Q is for <u>quince</u>, similar to a pear and is bright golden yellow.
- R is for <u>radish</u>, red and white with a bite!
- S is for **spinach**, a dark leafy green.
- T is for <u>tomato</u>, juicy and usually red. It can be a vegetable or a fruit.
- U is for <u>ugli</u>, a citrus fruit that is a cross between an orange, grapefruit, and tangerine.
- V is for <u>Victorian plum</u>, an English plum that is yellow and red.
- W is for watermelon, a summer snack that is juicy and red with black seeds.
- X X is for Xigua, the Chinese name for watermelon!
- Y is for <u>vam</u>, sometimes called a sweet potato.
- **7.** Z is for **zucchini**, a member of the squash family.
