NOTE 1 BASIS OF PRESENTATION

The accompanying schedule of expenditures of federal awards (the Schedule) includes the federal award activity of the University of Rhode Island (the University) under programs of the federal government for the year ended June 30, 2025. The information in this Schedule is presented in accordance with the requirements of 2 CFR Part 200, Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards (Uniform Guidance). Because the Schedule presents only a selected portion of the operations of the University, it is not intended to, and does not, present the financial position, changes in net assets, or cash flows of the University.

NOTE 2 SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Expenditures reported on the Schedule are reported on the accrual basis of accounting. Such expenditures are recognized following the cost principles contained in the Uniform Guidance, wherein certain types of expenditures are not allowable or are limited as to reimbursement. Negative amounts shown on the Schedule represent adjustments or credits made in the normal course of business to amounts reported as expenditures in prior years.

NOTE 3 DETERMINATION OF MAJOR PROGRAMS

The determination of major federal financial assistance programs was based on the overall level of expenditures for all federal programs for the state of Rhode Island (the State), of which University of Rhode Island is a component unit. As such, the determination of major programs is made at the State level, where it was determined there were no major programs during the State fiscal year ended June 30, 2025.

NOTE 4 INDIRECT COST RATE

The University elected not to use the 10% de minimis indirect cost rate allowed under the Uniform Guidance.
