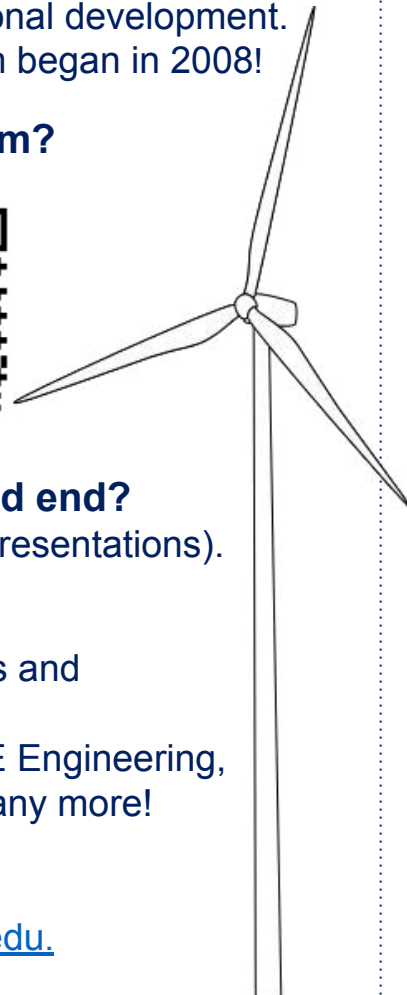


### What is the URI Energy Fellows Program? Why should I apply?
