Spring 2025 Semester Roadmap

From April 2nd to May 8th, 2025

April 4th : (F): Mubariz will send email, with Google Form to be filled on Sunday, April 6th, between 8 & 9pm, with submission of Homework #15.

April 8th: (T): Submission of TPS#20, with Bestrack#11 & HW #15 (Summit Doc), as 2 separate attachments. See Format of TPS#20 on the website.

April 11th: (F): Mubariz will send email, with Google Form to be filled on Sunday, April 13th, between 8 and 9pm, with submission of Homework #16 (Virtual Summit Slides).

April 11th: (F): Discuss format of the CPR with your Technical Directors. (or during this week)

April 13th: (Sunday): CPR submitted if ABO has been achieved; see Format on the website. If ABO not achieved, submit WPR#18, with Bestrack#11

April 13th (Sunday): Homework #16 Symposium Slides are due via google form to Mubariz. Note: you will not submit to your TDs until TPS #21 on Tuesday, April 15th.

April 15th: (T): Submission of TPS#21, with *Bestrack #12, if applicable*. Homework #16 (Summit Slides for approval), as 2 separate attachments. See Format of TPS#21 on the website.

April 18th: (F): Discuss CPR DRAFT with your TDs for any additions/modifications needed. (or during this week)

April 20th (Sunday): FINAL Comprehensive Progress Report (CPR) due, by **ALL teams: ABO achieved or not!**; 8-9pm; Send e-copy to your TDs, Consulting TDs and Professor Sunak. (Due only if changes were made to the DRAFT, as needed by your TDs, to include new results)

IMPORTANT NOTE: If ABO has not been achieved, the team is encouraged to continue working on the project, during the week April 21st through April 25th. You will then have the option to update the CPR and send it on

Saturday, April 26th. Individual scores will be updated accordingly, after consulting with your TDs. You have to let me and your TD know, if you intend to do this.

April 22nd (Tuesday): Final Virtual Summit Poster Submission; between 5 and 6pm. use the Resources and Templates available on the website. See Format on website.

- Microsoft PowerPoint

- Microsoft Publisher
- LibreOffice (It is preferred that you save the document in Microsoft format; an option available in the menu)

The following formats are NOT editable, and must NOT be used:

- PDF
- Image Formats (JPG/PNG/etc.)

April 29th (Monday): Mubariz will send the posters for printing to the Engineering Computer Center: ecc-help-group@uri.edu

April 29th (Monday): Last Day of Classes: Mubariz will send Google Form to record Final Cumulative Hours Worked for the Spring Semester (S), for each designer, to determine the Effort Grade, out of 5%. Data for the Total Hours (T) worked for the full year will also be compiled: $T = S + F + W$; W: Winter Break; (J-Term); F: Fall Semester.

Mubariz will also communicate the best method to send him Appendices B, C and D from the CPR: Appendix B: Team and Individual Testimonials; Appendix C: Employment Status for all Capstone Designers.
