# Spring 2025 Semester Roadmap From April 13<sup>th</sup> to May 8<sup>th</sup>, 2025

April 13<sup>th</sup>: (Sunday): CPR submitted if ABO has been achieved; see Format on the website. If ABO not achieved, submit WPR#18, with Bestrack#11

April 13<sup>th</sup> (Sunday): Homework #16 Symposium Slides are due via google form to Mubariz. Note: you will not submit to your TDs until TPS #21 on Tuesday, April 15th.

April 15<sup>th</sup>: (T): Submission of TPS#21, with *Bestrack #12, if applicable.*Homework #16 (Summit Slides for approval), as 2 separate attachments. See Format of TPS#21 on the website. Logbooks checked.

April 18<sup>th</sup>: (F): Discuss CPR DRAFT with your TDs for any additions/modifications needed. (or during this week). Logbooks checked.

April 20th (Sunday): FINAL Comprehensive Progress Report (CPR) due, by ALL teams: ABO achieved or not! 8-9pm; Send e-copy to your TDs, Consulting TDs and Professor Sunak. (Due only if changes were made to the DRAFT, as needed by your TDs, to include new results) FINAL CUTOFF DATE for recording Cumulative Hours Worked for Spring Semester (S) for each designer to determine the Effort Grade out of 5%. Total Hours (T) worked for the full year will also be compiled: T = S + F + W; W: Winter Break; (J-Term); F: Fall Semester.

IMPORTANT NOTE: If ABO has not been achieved, the team is encouraged to continue working on the project, during the week April 21<sup>st</sup> through April 25<sup>th</sup>. You will then have the option to update the CPR and send it on Saturday, April 26<sup>th</sup>. Individual scores will be updated accordingly, after consulting with your TDs. You have to let me, and your TD know, if you intend to do this.

April 22<sup>nd</sup> (Tuesday): Final Capstone Meeting: 5-8 pm.

Final Summit Poster Submission; between 5 and 6pm. use the Resources and Templates available on the website. See Format on website.

- Google Slides
- Microsoft PowerPoint
- Microsoft Publisher
- LibreOffice (It is preferred that you save the document in Microsoft format, an option available in the menu)

The following formats are NOT editable, and must NOT be used:

- PDF
- Image Formats (JPG/PNG/etc.)
