COLLEGE OF THE ENVIRONMENT AND LIFE SCIENCES (CELS)

Marine Technical Undergraduate Certificate

- 1. Students who have been admitted to an undergraduate degree program may enroll in the Marine Technical Undergraduate Certificate while completing their degree requirements.
- 2. Requirements may be satisfied by completing 12 credits from the courses listed below. Students must receive a minimum grade of C in each class and an overall average of B (3.0) or higher.
- 3. Transfer credits may not be used to fulfil requirements.
- 4. Courses may be used to apply to both the major and minor fields of study.
- 5. Courses may not be taken under pass-fail grade option.
- Credits applied must have been taken within eight years of enrolling in the certificate and cannot total more than one quarter of the total number of credits required.
- 7. Students must complete all requirements within 5 years of their certificate enrollment date and prior to or upon degree conferral.
- 8. The certificate form should be filed with the Dean's office that represents the department/program sponsoring the Certificate prior to applying for graduation but after receiving the signature of the FAVS Department Chair or Marine Technical Certificate coordinator.
- 9. Enrollment in the certificate does not guarantee space in any required course.
- 10. Upon completion the credentials will be listed on the student's permanent academic record and an official certificate will be mailed to the student within 6-8 weeks.
