The Office of International Education invites you to learn more about these scholarship opportunities. The sessions will be presented by a former URI and Gilman Alum.

The Benjamin A. Gilman International Scholarship Program is seeking to broaden the range of people who participate in study abroad programs. If you are a recipient of the Pell Grant, you may be eligible for up to \$5,000 towards a study abroad program (and potentially an additional \$3,000 if you intend to study a recognized critical need language)!

The Info Sessions will also include information on **The John S. McCain International Scholarship for Military Families (Gilman-McCain Scholarship)** The scholarship provides awards of \$5,000 for undergraduate child and spousal dependents of active or activated United States military personnel during the time of application.
