- A. Changes to Graduate School staffing (Mouw)
 - 1. Dr. Colleen Mouw is the new Acting Dean of the Graduate School and also serves as the Associate Dean. The Dean position was posted and Dr. Mouw is in the candidate pool.

B. Enrollment Update (Kulesh)

1. Dr. Kulesh noted an 11% increase for Fall 2025 applications compared to the previous year and announced that applications for Summer and Fall 2026, and Spring 2027 are

now available in the new Slate system. She also introduced a monthly newsletter for graduate program directors to provide timely updates and information.

C. Professional Development (Mitnick)

1. Dr. Mitnick presented updates on graduate professional development programs, iDiversity and Inclusion Badge Program (DIBP) and Equitable and Inclusive Teaching and Pedagogy Badge Program (EITP), with registration now open for both. She highlighted the rebranding of the Graduate Writing Center to the Graduate Writing and Presenting Lab, and introduced a new grant writing tool developed by Heather Johnson, which is now available to students, faculty, and postdocs. Upcoming events and various workshops were announced, and encouraged faculty to promote these resources to their students.

VI. New Business

- A. Graduate Council Committee Appointments (Mouw)

- B. EGRA Awards (Mouw)

- D. Emerging Student Issues (Mouw)
 - 1. Dr. Mouw discussed graduate housing issues, noting that Graduate Village will be entirely vacated during construction of a new facility, with current leaseholders potentially offered on-campus housing, though details remain unclear. She shared that graduate students have secured monthly meetings with administration about housing concerns through their union contract. Dr. Mouw also addressed new campus fees, emphasizing that while she was not involved in their implementation, she would work to improve transparency in future fee decisions.
