



Sequencing of Revisions




Sequencing of Revisions



Formatting is usually an iterative process. It is finished when the manuscript is "Accepted" online.

However, nothing will be finalized at the etdadmin web site until the final submission email is received by the Graduate School. At that time, the manuscript will be "Delivered to **ProQuest**".

If more comments need to be incorporated after the manuscript is accepted, the status can be walked-back to "Minor Revisions Required" so the comments can be incorporated.



 - Permission is required from the Graduate School.
 Decisions will be made on a case-by-case basis.
