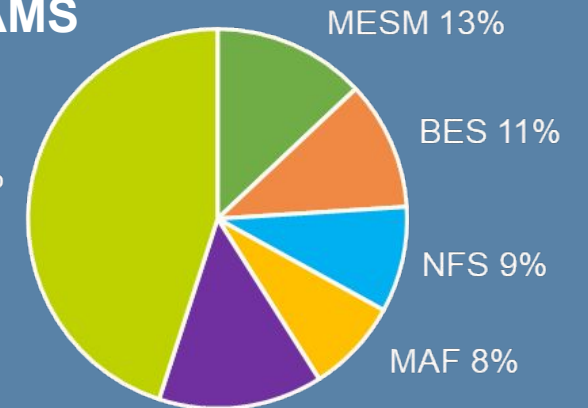

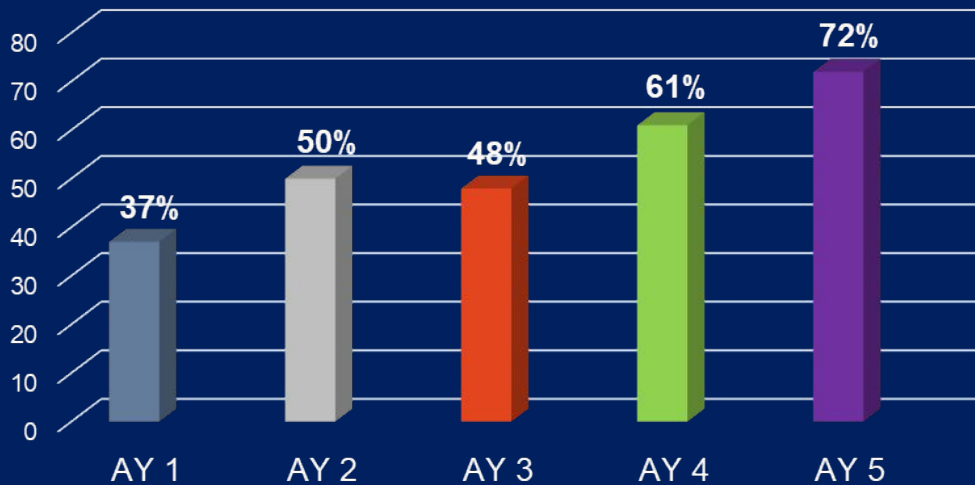

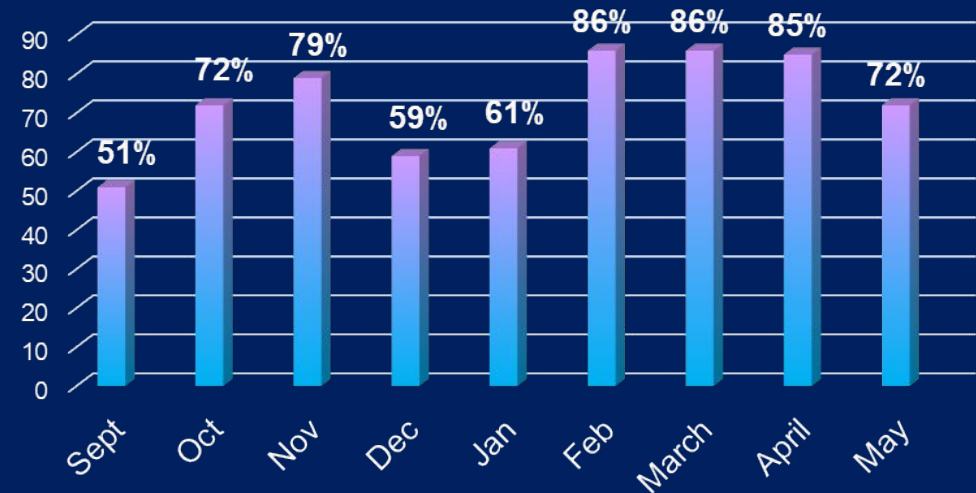


2022-2023 Utilization Comparisons

GWC Academic Year Utilization

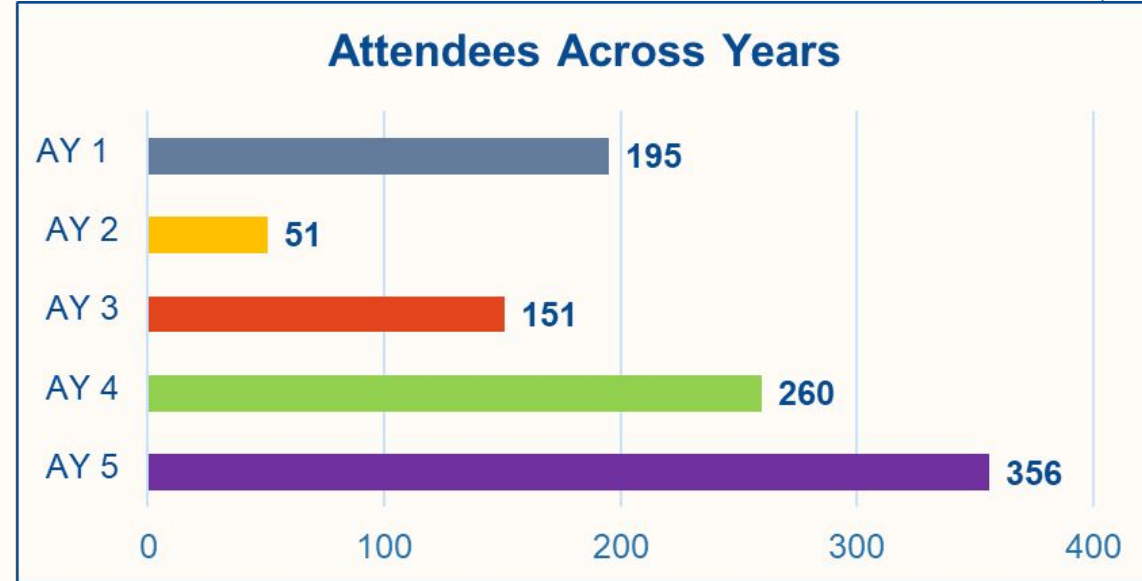
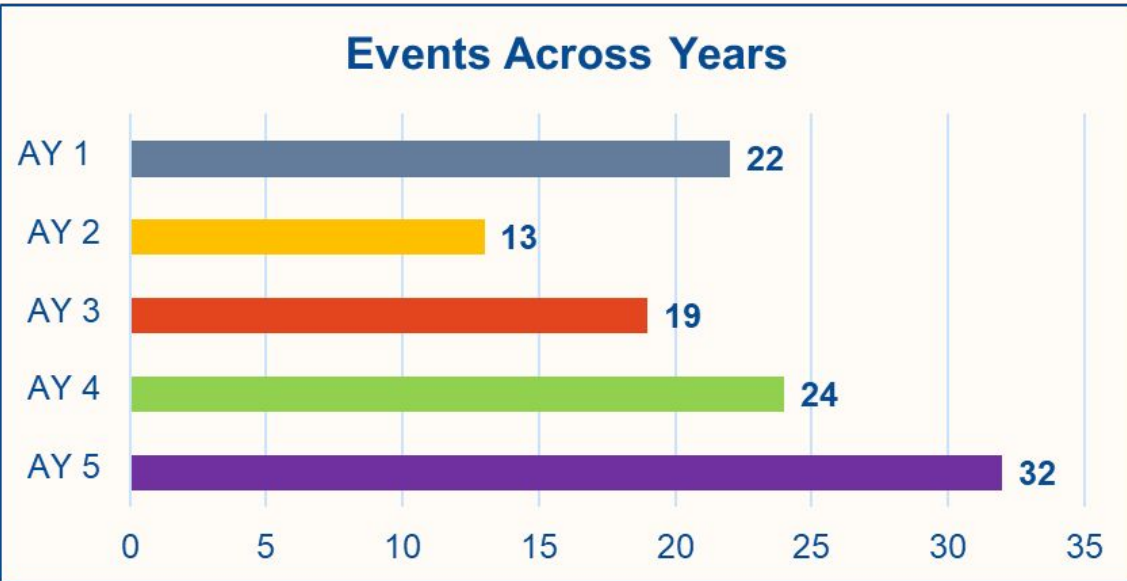


GWC Monthly Utilization for AY5
