    Avoid Abbreviations, The Title should clearly describe what you want to present.
  - o Author(s) information: Names and Institution or program major and email
  - Abstract (not exceed 500 words): Abbreviations may be used but must be defined on the first usage
  - Summary of Research (Objectives, Methods, Results): should include more detailed information that will give reviewers a clear picture of the content of the presentation (not exceeding 1000 words)
  - Conclusion and significance of the findings and learning objectives (not exceed 250 words) Briefly list 3-5 things that attendees will learn from your presentation.
- **Submission Format:** Abstracts must be submitted in PDF format.
- Submission Deadline: Dec 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024 March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025
- Notification of Acceptance: Authors will be notified of acceptance by March 15<sup>th</sup>

#### **Submission Process:**

Please submit your abstracts via the conference submission *portal link*. Ensure that all required information is included and that your abstract adheres to the specified guidelines.

#### **Presentation Formats:**

- ❖ Oral Presentations: Selected abstracts will be invited for a 15-minute oral presentation followed by a 5-minute Q&A session.
- ❖ **Poster Presentations:** Selected abstracts will be invited to present a poster during the designated poster session.
