Submission Guidelines:

- **Eligibility:** Open to all graduate students currently enrolled in a master's or doctoral program.
- **Title and Text: Type with single line space, 12 font size Times New Roman**
 - Title of the presentation (not exceeding 20 words)
Avoid Abbreviations, The Title should clearly describe what you want to present.
 - Author(s) information: Names and Institution or program major and email
 - Abstract (not exceed 500 words): Abbreviations may be used but must be defined on the first usage
 - Summary of Research (Objectives, Methods, Results): should include more detailed information that will give reviewers a clear picture of the content of the presentation (not exceeding 1000 words)
 - Conclusion and significance of the findings and learning objectives (not exceed 250 words) Briefly list 3-5 things that attendees will learn from your presentation.
- **Submission Format:** Abstracts must be submitted in PDF format.
- **Submission Deadline:** Dec 1st, 2024 – March 1st, 2025
- **Notification of Acceptance:** Authors will be notified of acceptance by March 15th

Submission Process:

Please submit your abstracts via the conference submission [*portal link*](#). Ensure that all required information is included and that your abstract adheres to the specified guidelines.

Presentation Formats:

- ❖ **Oral Presentations:** Selected abstracts will be invited for a 15-minute oral presentation followed by a 5-minute Q&A session.
- ❖ **Poster Presentations:** Selected abstracts will be invited to present a poster during the designated poster session.
