Detailed instructions on our website will guide you through the requirements. Below is a checklist of actions that need to be completed. All URI students have a URI email account (uri.edu) and must register for SSO (single sign-on).

Full-time Rhode Island In-State Students: If you have received your vaccinations in Rhode Island, we will obtain your dates through an interface with the state immunization registry, you do not need to enter the dates. However, you must complete the online forms. We will contact you via email for any missing requirements. ☐ Complete the Required Online Forms in the Patient Portal under the Forms tab Health History for New Students Student and Emergency Contact Form TB Screening Form (Note: If you answer Yes to any of the questions, you must take the TB Risk Assessment form to your medical provider, have it completed and upload it under the Upload tab) Texting Opt-in/Opt-out Form ☐ Upload Completed Documents in the Patient Portal o Full-time Out-of-State Students ONLY: Immunization Record (you can use records from your doctor **OR** have your doctor complete the URI Immunization Record) Out-of-State Students ONLY who received COVID vaccines: COVID-19 Vaccination Card (or other proof of vaccination) if Covid vaccination dates are not on the immunization record you upload o Photograph of all medications you currently take Photo or copy of the **FRONT** and **BACK** of your health insurance card. Note: this is not the waiver. Consent to Treat a Minor Form (**ONLY** if under 18 years of age by arrival at URI) Physical Exam form (not required, but recommended if dated within the last 18 months) TB/Tuberculosis Risk Assessment Form (only if required based on answers to the TB Screening Form) ☐ Waive the URI Student Health Insurance if you have comparable health coverage Log into your e-Campus account (uri.edu/ecampus) Note: this is different than the patient portal. o Go to Menu in the top left corner and select URI Student Services, then select Insurance Waiver. Please note that URI Student Health Insurance must be waived annually.
