Facilities Operations is preparing for winter snow removal and making opportunities available for URI employees' campus-wide to assist and volunteer with snow removal efforts.

Employees interested and available to assist campus Grounds or Custodial crews with snow removal tasks after their normal work shift can visit the Facilities Lands & Grounds Building to sign-up, or contact Paul Neri directly 874.4370/pneri@uri.edu **with your employee id#, date of hire, department & phone number no later than December 30th** to be added to the volunteer list.

Reasonable efforts to train employees for specific tasks, such as: operating truck plows, operating snow blowers, snow shoveling and applying ice melt salts will be provided.

Overtime pay/Comp-time commensurate with the employee's union/contract agreement will be paid to those for hours worked.

Employees who sign up on the Facilities snow removal volunteer list will be contacted by Facilities Management as needed for storms.

Advance notice will be given prior to storms when volunteer help is needed. Volunteers may be asked to assist either Grounds or Custodial crews with snow removal efforts.

When signing up, please indicate prior experience, if any, for snow removal tasks and equipment you have experience operating.

Should we do not get enough people from C94/L528, we will take from other unions.
