## Early Intervention Certificate Application Form

- 1. Students who have been admitted to an undergraduate degree program may enroll in the Early Intervention Certificate while completing their degree requirements.
- 2. Requirements must be satisfied by completing the courses listed below (a total of 12 credits)\*. Students must complete this coursework with an average of C (2.0) or higher.
- 3. Transfer credits may not be used to fulfill requirements
- 4. Courses may be used to apply to major, minor, and/or general education requirements.
- 5. Courses may not be taken under the pass-fail grade option.
- 6. Credits taken prior to the certificate must have been completed within eight years prior to applying and cannot total more than two-fifths (40%) of the total number of credits required.
- 7. Students must complete all requirements within 5 years of their certificate enrollment date and prior to or upon degree conferral.
- 8. The certificate form should be filed with the College of Health Sciences Dean's Office prior to applying for graduation but after receiving the signature of the Certificate Director in the Department of Human Development and Family Science.
- 9. Enrollment in the certificate does not guarantee space in any required course.

10. Upon degree conferral, the certificate will be listed on the student's permanent academic record and an official certificate will be mailed to the student within 6-8 week.
