Summer 2025 Student Checklist

Before arriving on campus the following items should be completed.

- ☐ **Set up your student Single Sign-On (SSO)** to access e-Campus. E-Campus is the University's student records system for registration, grades, billing, and financial aid.
- ☐ **Check your student e-Campus "To Do List":** It is important to monitor your e-Campus "To Do List" throughout the summer for outstanding/missing Financial Aid items. To access e-Campus: <https://its.uri.edu/ecampus/>
- ☐ **Complete your student Financial Responsibility Agreement:** A completed agreement is required in order to register for classes, so be sure to complete this task before arriving at orientation. To get started, log into e-Campus and click on the Financial Responsibility Agreement item in your "To Do List" and then follow the prompts.
- ☐ **Submit your student Health Insurance Waiver:** All full-time students must have health insurance. A charge for the Accident/Sick Health Insurance plan will appear on your bill. Students with comparable coverage may file a waiver, and if approved, the charge will be removed.

- ☐ **Set up your student Refund Delivery Preference with BankMobile:** BankMobile allows students to receive refunds via an existing bank account or a BankMobile online bank account.
 - Set Up Refund Preference with BankMobile in e-Campus: URI Student Financials --> My Refunds.

NOTE: Although you might not currently expect a refund from URI, you may receive money back in the future. Reasons for refunds include dropping classes, making an overpayment, or applying for a loan to pay for off-campus housing. Establishing your refund preference now ensures you'll always have any available refunds without a delay.

- ☐ **Create Access to your Payment and e-Bill Portal (Flywire):** URI has partnered with Flywire to provide 24/7 financial account access. View your bill, make a payment, enroll for a payment plan, and invite parents and supporters to be authorized users on your account. Enrollment for the URI Monthly Payment Plan begins in early May. - ☐ **If Borrowing Federal Direct Student Loans:** First-time federal loan borrowers must complete the following before aid can be credited to the student's term bill.
 1. **Accept or decline student loans** through e-Campus.
 2. **Complete federal Loan Entrance Counseling.**
 - This ensures that the student understands the terms and conditions of the loan along with their rights and responsibilities. This is done via studentaid.gov.
 3. **Complete federal Master Promissory Note (MPN).**
 - This is a legal document in which the student promises to repay their loans with interest to the US Department of Education. This is done via studentaid.gov.
