**Entry and Progression Policy** 

- Entry into the College of Nursing is competitive and seats are limited. Students are required to have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 and a grade of "C" or better in all prerequisite courses to be considered. Entrance into the College of Nursing and clinical course sequence is **not** guaranteed once meeting these requirements. Placement is competitively granted based on success in prerequisite criteria. Those who meet the minimum criteria but do not achieve a seat will be considered the following semester, in the same competitive manner. The College of Nursing and clinical course sequence is **not** guaranteed on the 2025-2026 academic year, students who meet the above criteria will enter the College of Nursing in the fall semester only
- Students who have not met the pre-requisite criteria for transfer to the College of Nursing and the clinical course sequence by the end of two years or sixty credits will be required to choose a different major at the University.
- Progression through the College of NUR requires a "C" or better in all NUR courses and a minimum 2.20 GPA. Students are allowed to repeat a single NUR course as outlined in the dismissal policy. Should a student need to repeat a class or otherwise fall out of sequence continuation will be on a space available basis and is *not* guaranteed for the following semester. The student will be notified of eligibility.
- Dismissal Policy: Performance below a grade of "C" in any 2 nursing courses will result in dismissal from the College of Nursing. Please refer to the University Catalog and The College of Nursing Student Handbook for full details.
