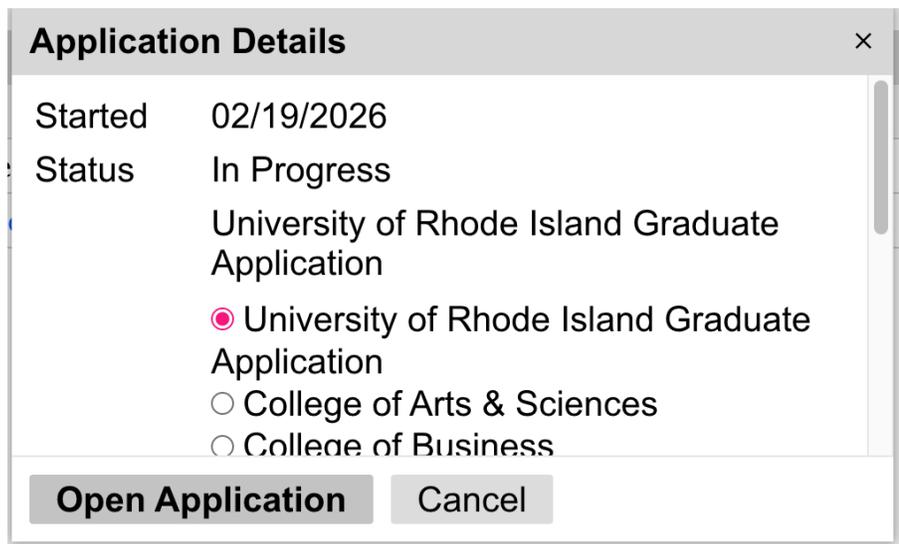

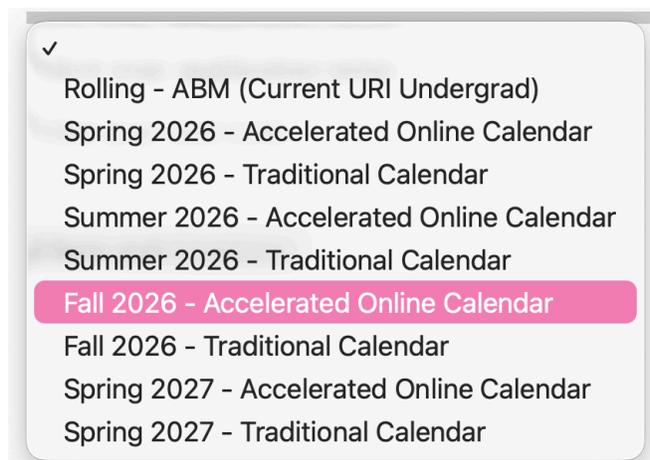

Additional Application Instructions:

Personal Statement – Please submit a two-paragraph applicant statement. In the first paragraph, discuss positions held and expertise gained since the internship. In the second paragraph, describe why you want to complete the MS Dietetics Program. Upload this to the “**Documents**” section of the graduate school application.

Transcripts – Unofficial transcripts from all institutions of higher education must be included in the graduate school application. Upload this to the “**Education History**” section of the graduate school application.

Official transcripts are also required. **Official electronic transcripts may be sent via Credentials Solutions, Parchment, and National Student Clearinghouse. When using Parchment, please be sure to select the University of Rhode Island - Graduate Admissions for the destination. Official *paper* transcripts, including foreign non-evaluated official transcripts, should be sent to: URI Graduate School 204 Quinn Hall 55 Lower College Road, Kingston, RI 02881.** Follow the steps listed in the “**Education History**” section of the graduate school application.

Resume – Please submit a current resume/CV. Upload this to the “**Documents**” section of the graduate school application.

Recommendations – Please submit three letters of recommendation. Insert the name and contact information for each recommendation provider under the “**Recommendations**” section of the graduate school application.
