
PARTICIPANTS NEEDED!

Seeking participants for a URI Department of Kinesiology research study!

You may be eligible to participate if:

- You are over 50 years old
- You are a cognitively healthy adult
 OR
- You have been diagnosed with cognitive impairment and have a study partner to accompany you to all research visits
- You speak English fluently
- You can walk on your own without any device for at least 30 minutes at a time







Participants will:

- Come to the URI Motion Analysis Lab for a total of 14 visits
 - o Twice a week for 6 weeks (12 1-hour visits)
 - o Two additional visits for baseline and post-test measures (2 hours each visit)
- Participate in an augmented reality (AR)
 walking program using a gaming headset
 and completing a virtual obstacle course
 in the laboratory
