

Shoulder Motor Control Study: Rotator Cuff

Seeking Participants for Shoulder Motor Control Study

PURPOSE

Compare shoulder motor control and muscle activity of adults with and without rotator cuff repair surgery

REQUIREMENTS

Participation is voluntary. Participants should be 18-64 years old either with or without shoulder surgery and should not have limitations in mobility due to other medical conditions.

WHAT WILL YOU BE ASKED TO DO?

You will be asked to complete questionnaires regarding your health and physical function.

You will be asked to wear electrode sensors both on the surface of the skin and inserted into the muscle.

You will be asked to perform tests and measures to assess your upper limb mobility, strength and motor control.

You will be asked to attend one session at URI's Physical Therapy department which will last approximately 4 hours
