- **Regular shifts*** (weekend or weekday) at the Sachuest Point Visitor Center, Middletown
- **Alternates** who can sub in for vacant shifts as they arise at Kettle Pond or Sachuest Point.

*Regular shifts can be weekly, bi-weekly, or monthly. Weekend shifts are highest need.

Are you a retired teacher or naturalist?

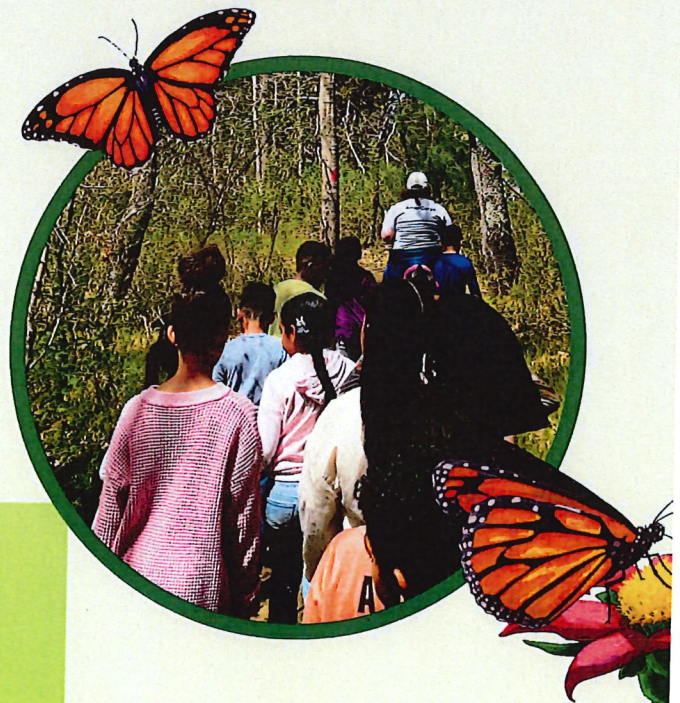
Environmental Education volunteers help orient school groups and provide a guided walk or lesson at Kettle Pond or Sachuest Point.
