## Additional Information

The Bachelor of Science in Nursing requires *120* credits for graduation consisting of nursing courses, science courses, general education, and free elective credits. The curriculum provides students with the opportunity to work with expert nursing faculty and to explore the health needs of diverse populations.

### **Entry and Progression Policy**

- **Progression through the College of NUR** requires a “C” or better in all NUR courses, STA 220, BPS 333, WRT 104 and a minimum 2.20 GPA. Students are allowed to repeat a single NUR course as outlined in the dismissal policy.
- **Dismissal Policy:** Performance below a grade of “C” in any 2 nursing courses will result in dismissal from the College of Nursing. Please refer to the University Catalog and The College of Nursing Academic Policy for full dismissal policy.
