Inquiry revealed that department policy was not followed, and officer was in violation of department policies and procedures.		
23-2	2-IA	An Internal Affairs (IA) case number was mistakenly initiated from the IMC computer aided dispatch/records management software system by the supervisor who was directed to conduct and inquiry into sick leave usage of a department employee. The inquiry was conducted administratively and was not intended to be an internal affairs complaint. Per department policy, case numbers are prohibited to be deleted from CADRMS under any circumstances.
