

University of Rhode Island Administrative Policy Committee

Charge: In accordance with the University's Policy on Policies, the Administrative Policy Committee (APC) is charged with reviewing and recommending to the President for approval new administrative policies and any changes to existing administrative policies.

Meetings: The APC will meet as needed, but generally monthly.

Committee Chair: The APC Chair shall be the Vice President for Administration and Finance

A quorum is defined as a simple majority of voting members. A vote of approval by a simple majority of members participating in a meeting is required for passage of action items.

In the event of a tie vote, the Chief of Staff / Deputy Chief of Staff to the President will determine the outcome.

The Policy Committee will be staffed by the Vice President for Administration and Finance and staff.
