**CHARGE**

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In accordance with the University's Policy on Policies, the Administrative Policy Committee is charged with reviewing and approving new administrative policies and any changes to existing administrative policies.

**Membership**

The members of the Administrative Policy Committee are:

- The President
- The Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs
- The Vice President for Administration and Finance (Chair)
- The Vice President for Student Affairs
- The Vice President for Research and Economic Development
- The Associate Vice President for Enrollment Management and Student Success
- The Dean of two colleges (two year terms, appointed by President)
- The Chief Information Officer
- The Chief Diversity Officer
- The Director of Athletics
- General Counsel
- Member of the Executive Board of the Faculty Senate
- The President of the University of Rhode Island Foundation and Alumni Engagement (non-voting)

A quorum is defined as a simple majority of voting members. A vote of approval by a simple majority of members participating in a meeting is required for passage of action items.

In the event of a tie vote, the President will determine the outcome.

The Policy Committee will be staffed by the Vice President for Administration and Finance and staff.
