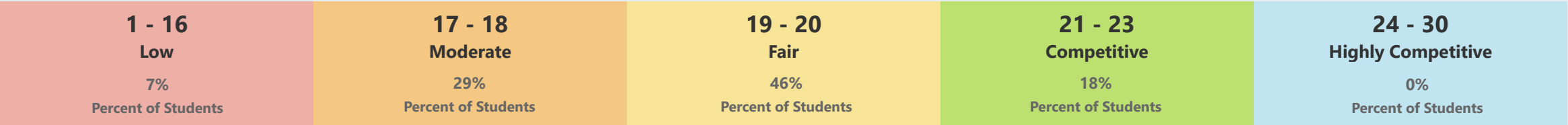

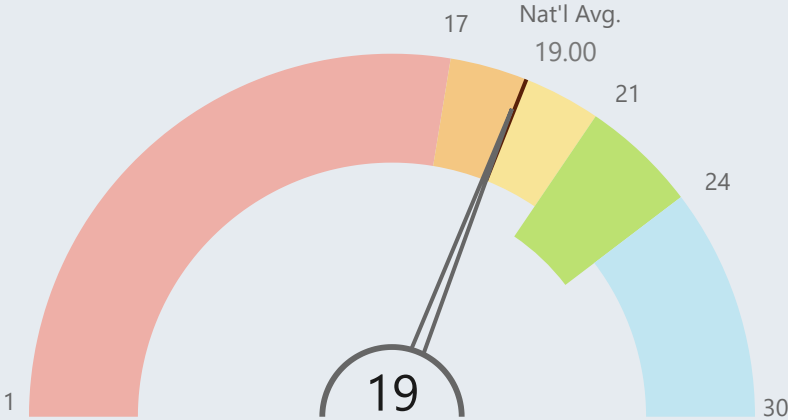

Average DAT Score of Applicants

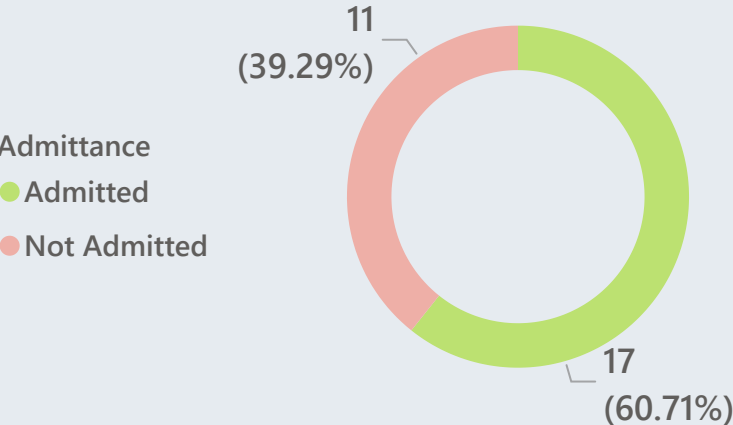

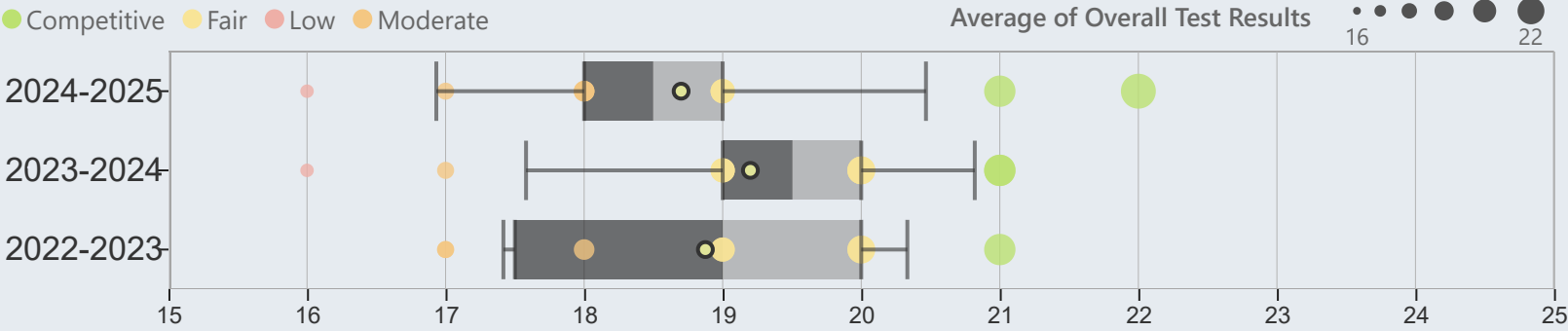

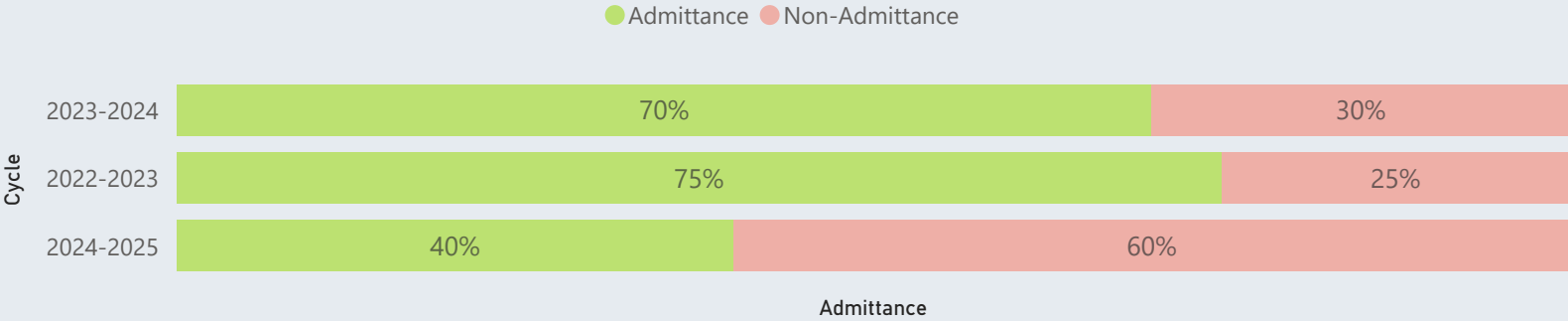
Dental Program Admittance Rates

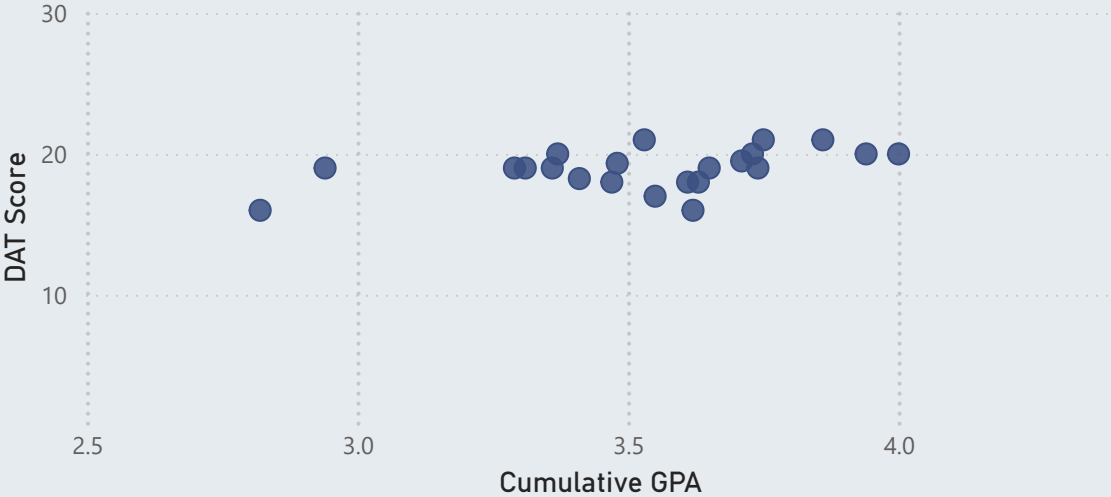
