Format: Your letter should be typed, signed, and printed on your institutional letterhead. Please address your letter, "To the Admissions Committee."

Accuracy: we know that evaluators are busy professionals, so we greatly appreciate the time you take to write your letter and carefully proofread it. Letters free of typos and other errors enhance applicants' chances of admission.

Deadlines: first-time HPAC applicants, February 15, 2024. Non-HPAC applicants, May 1, 2024. Re-applicants, June 1, 2024. Some applicants may have exceptions to these deadlines.

NOTE: URI Pre-Health Advising urges all applicants to request letters of recommendation as early as possible, and not less than two weeks before any deadline.
