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Instructions

Prior learning assessment (PLA) is the process used by the University of Rhode Island to award academic credit for a student's knowledge and expertise acquired through life and professional experience when the student's knowledge and skills are determined to be equivalent to college-level learning.

Credit award determinations are made by the faculty sponsor, and any additional assessing subject matter expert(s), who will maintain final determination of the student's prior learning as equivalent or not-equivalent to college-level learning.

To complete this request, this form needs to be completed, submitted, and signed by all parties. For each requested PLA course, an individual request form needs to be completed as the requests will be evaluated individual on a case-by-case basis.

For each course, you must identify a subject matter expert who will complete the final evaluation and determine credit awards. The assessing faculty member may be the same for multiple courses, or change per course, based on the different academic domains you are attempting to gain PLA credit in.

For Prior Learning Assessments, this form must be completed and returned to the PLA coordinator by the end of the drop-add period for the semester the student will attempt PLA in.
