Hours & Credits	<u>Combined</u> field experience & seminar credit 3 credits = 60 total hrs (6 hrs/wk, 10 wks)	<u>Separate</u> field experience & seminar credit* ITR 302 (<i>field experience</i>) = variable credit & hours. See over for information. ITR 304 (<i>seminar</i>) = 3 credits <i>* ITR302&304 are taken concurrently</i>
Pre-requisite	PSY 113	Minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA Minimum of 60 earned credits
Registration Procedure	Students may register for the course in e-campus. Procurement of an internship prior to the semester is <i>strongly recommended</i> but not required. Where to begin: Register in e-campus and contact the PSY 305 instructor.	Students register with permission number by individual appointment with their ITR advisor. Procurement of an internship prior to the start of the semester is <i>required</i> . Where to begin: Complete the ITR Internship Information Session module: Go to: uri.edu/career/professional-development-modules/
Internship Deadline	The 3 rd week of the internship semester. Recommended that students secure the internship prior to the start of the internship semester.	One week BEFORE the internship semester. Recommended that students secure their internship the semester before the internship semester.
Internship Seminar	Meets once per week for 1 hr & 15 minutes Sections in Providence and Kingston	Meets online through Brightspace
PSY Experiential Requirement	Fulfills PSY Experiential requirement Must earn a grade of "C" or better	Fulfills PSY experiential requirement* Must earn a grade of "C" or better <i>*students using ITR for the requirement must be sure to complete a total of 32 credits with PSY course code (see your curriculum sheet)</i>
Total credits	Students may earn up to 6 credits of PSY305 in separate semesters (3 credits per semester).	Students may earn up to 24 credits of ITR 302 in separate semesters (students will only take ITR 304 for the first internship).
Best for...	Sophomores/juniors completing their first internship OR students who need to fulfill the experiential requirement, but have limited availability in their schedule.	Great option for students who want a fuller internship experience, who may be completing a second or third internship, or who have a large amount of availability in their schedule.

ITR Internship Program Information

- ▶ We provide academic credit for quality internship experiences in virtually any field
- ▶ Students may participate in paid and unpaid internships for academic credit anywhere in the US
- ▶ Students can pursue an internship from our established placements or search for new opportunities

Career Education Specialist

- ▶ Students will be assigned to a Career Education Specialist (CES) based on cluster/major
- ▶ PSY CES: Ashley Foley, afoley@uri.edu

Student Requirements

- ▶ Minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA
- ▶ Undergraduate student with a minimum of 60 earned credits prior to the internship
- ▶ Must be a URI student in good academic and social standing with the university

Important Dates

- ▶ Begin Your Internship Search: At least one semester prior to the internship
- ▶ Internship Must Be Finalized: One week before the start of classes of the internship semester
- ▶ Internship Dates: First day to last day of classes of the semester

Hours & Credits

- ▶ Students will earn 300-level credits
- ▶ ITR credit is just like class credit; students may not take more than 19 **total** credits in one semester
