Any student can work hourly during the academic year and summer; 20 hrs max - academic year/40 hrs - summer.

Students paid hourly (not GRAs) do not qualify for fringe benefits during the academic year; 7.65% FICA - summer.

All But Dissertation (ABD) GRAs should be budgeted for stipends, fringe, fees (100%), and in-state, regional, or out-state tuition at 33.34% of the annual amount.

Undergraduate students typically do not get annual increases.

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
