E. PUBLIC FORUM

URI's Chief of Police Michael Jagoda and Transportation and Parking Director Joe Paradise Chief of Police:

- Crime Statistics really show how safe it is on campus
- Respectful Campus that doesn't tolerate disrespect all around
- Want to not only make it a safe and secure campus but also make sure that everyone's voice is hold
- Looked at all of the policies to make sure they are doing constitutional policing
- Not just his police department but our the students police department
- Wishes to provide superior services for this campus
- Using more social media to connect with the community
- Hopes that we can do our Student Senate blue light safety walk in the next few weeks
- Whatever services that we can provide to make your experience more safer and effective we want to give to you

Joe Paradise:

- Trying to open the communication with Student Senate
- Wants to do some media work with Student Senate
- We do a lot of things in the summer to make improvements around campus
- Wayfinding project: App that students will be able to see what parking is available in every lot
- We're going to see a lot of progress this year with the app
- Board of Trustees improved the upgraded parking regulations this year: more clarification of parking rights, improvement of license plate readers and new technologies
- At the begging of the semester we try to send out communications to everyone regarding parking on campus
- Metered parking now for students that don't need a full parking permit
- First offenses parking tickets are automatically reduced
- Communication aspect is getting better, and trying to share more
- Wishes to grow the social media more
- Shuttles: Very challenging because of the way that we operate, trying to make them quicker and on time. Wants to make sure shuttle at URI are easier to access from the plains road lot to make it more accessible for commuters.
- On demand service: 5:30-1am runs seven days a week, last year over 8000 rides,
- Problem with on demand service: No shows; enforcing the policy that if you do no shows, 3 no shows means no access to on demand services for the rest of the semester
- This year we have 1103 rides, trending to be how it was last year
- RIPTA: pilot program, on demand, curb to curb service. Like Uber but for the South County area. Thinking of adding another shuttle because demand is so high. Really good program.

Chief of Police:

 URI on demand service is free, so anyone that doesn't have access to transportation to and from campus

Speaker Peckham:

- Wondering how Brookside parking passes were determined?

Joe paradises:

- There are 162 parking spaces in Brookside so we do not oversell that. Flagg road lots tend to be able to fit more permits because people tend to not park there. Brookside is now on night patrol, same for Greek housing.

Senator Buono:

- Would like to have the Student Senate play a larger role in social media for parking.
 More appealing if we present it to students. There is a lot of resources out there already but would it to be from student to student
- Sign up sheets for actors in a social media presentation

Senator Walding:

- URI EMS has four parking spots, and when we park at EMS we normally get ticketed. Is there any way we can get some accommodations?

Joe Paradises:

- That is definitely something that we can revisit, but unfortunately that lot is competing with faculty and staff for those spots.

Head Jurist:

- Representative for Military and veterans on campus
- Extends his thanks for helping the national guard get parking on campus

Joe Paradises:

- I served, and was happy to work with veterans, working on discounts for veterans
- Wishes to take care of the veterans

Senator Hailu:

- Question about no show students with the on demand service
 - Some drivers don't stop and mark students as no shows

Joe Paradises:

- If we get complaints we look at them, GPS tracking is part of the program so if there is a complaint we look into it
- We did have some issues for drivers but we do have to go through the app and rely on it
- Wants to hear more constructive criticism

Speaker Peckham:

- I really appreciate the effort that TAP and the police department have on campus. I always look forward to coming and chatting, especially with the public safety tents. I'm sure not a lot of other campuses give the opportunity to connect. Thank you, we really appreciate and value you!
